P, S, A, and M modes are known as exposure modes and give photographers a choice as to which elements of exposure—aperture or shutter speed—they wish to control. ☐ Mode P (Programmed Auto)

Choose from these advanced shooting modes: Program Auto (P): Also known as Programmed Auto or Program AE. This advanced Auto mode combines the ease of point-and-shoot with the flexibility of the advanced shooting modes. When you press the shutter button halfway, the camera automatically sets the aperture and shutter speed for you.

On most DSLR cameras, there will also be the letter modes - M (Manual), AV (Aperture-Priority), TV or S (Shutter-Priority) and P (Programmed Auto). Manual mode required the photographer to set every single setting; Aperture-Priority allows the photographer to set the aperture value and the camera automatically sets the correct shutter speed

Depending upon the subject you are shooting, you may want to set a specific Focus Mode. For general video shooting, AF-S will suffice. AF-S is good to use for subjects that are not moving, AF-F is ideal for moving subjects. The other choice is MF or Manual Focus, which you may want to try as you get more experience shooting video with your HD-SLR.

There are three main autofocus modes on Nikon DSLRs: single, continuous and automatic. If you want to track a moving subject you need to select the continuous autofocusing mode (AF-C).

Some Nikon DSLRs offer more than one Continuous shooting mode. Your camera may have just a C (Continuous) or CL (Continuous low) and CH (Continuous high). The differences between CL and CH are often a few more frames per second continuous shooting when CH is selected than you'll get when CL is selected.

Using the Continuous Shooting Mode for Sports | Nikon

For the most control, choose P, S, A, or M. On/Off switch/Shutter button. Rotate the switch to power the camera on; rotate again to turn it off. Press the shutter button halfway to wake up the camera's exposure meter and initiate autofocusing. Press the rest of the way to take a picture.
